

DISTRICT SNAPSHOT

The Ventura County Fire Department (VCFD) is an allhazard, full-service agency. We proudly provide fire, emergency medical and rescue services in areas as diverse as urban centers, the coastline, farmland and wildland.

Formed in 1928 as a special district, VCFD serves more than 480,000 people in the unincorporated areas of Ventura County. Our response area covers 848 square miles, including the cities of Ojai, Port Hueneme, Moorpark, Camarillo, Simi Valley and Thousand Oaks. Ventura County has a total land area of 1,843 square miles, 42 miles of coastline and ranges in elevation from sea level to 8,831 feet at Mt. Pinos in the Los Padres National Forest.


