USAR (urban search and rescue) unit because of its heavy winch capabilities.

The water rescue unit responds on water rescues on both inland bodies of water, along the coastline or swiftwater emergencies. The trailer carries an Inflatable Rubber Boat with outboard motor, a Quad motorcycle, 2 Rescue Water Craft with "Life Sleds" and a paddleboard. Specialized water rescue tools and equipment are carried in the unit.
